

Spike Wattle *Acacia oxycedrus*

Flowers: August to November - H 1-2+ m x W 1-2m



An erect or spreading prickly shrub growing to 2 or more metres in height, though is generally smaller on the sandbelt. Prefers sandy soils but is adaptable & withstands periods of inundation & drought. Attractive cylindrical flowers are a very bright creamy-yellow in colour. Extremely prickly, making it a suitable shelter habitat for small birds. Noted for its showy flowering, being one of the best flowerers in the Wattle family.
