

Sweet Wattle *Acacia suaveolens*

Flowers: April to October - H 1-2+m x W 1-2m



Sender reasonably fast growing shrub, often open & spreading in form. Sweetly perfumed pale yellow flowers. Leaves long & narrow. Prefers well drained soils & is suited to full sun to partial shade. Selective pruning encourages a more vigorous leaf growth & a denser shrub. Noted as being salt tolerant. The Latin word *suaveolens* means sweet scented.
