

Swamp Sheoak *Allocasuarina paludosa*

Flowers: March to October - H 50cm-2m x W 1-2m.



Open sprawling shrub prefers well drained, moist & sandy soils or light clay in full sun to shaded positions. Adapted to drier soils & is drought resistant. Female plants have dark-red flowers & develop small seed cones, while males produces brown flowers on the end of the branchlets. Long-lived shrub with attractive soft foliage that is sufficiently open to allow for the establishment of smaller plants beneath it.
