

Sweet Bursaria *Bursaria spinosa* var. *macrophylla*

Flowers: December to January. H 4-6m x W 2-4m.



Sweet Bursaria grows to a shrub or small tree with those closer to the coast taller with fewer to no spines. Leaves are shiny and dark-green. Flowering with dense clusters of fragrant white flowers. Attractive bronze coloured seed pods follow flowering. Sweet Bursaria is a favourite with birds & butterflies. It makes an excellent garden tree if given an appropriate position & the time to establish. *Bursaria spinosa* var. *spinosa* differs from *Bursaria spinosa* var. *macrophylla* with shorter leaves. Both are long lived.
