

## Small-leaved Clematis *Clematis microphylla* var. *microphylla*

Flowers: July to November.



Vigorous and very showy climber with masses of cream starry flowers. Suits well drained dry soils, also found in dune areas. Male and female flowers develop on different plants. The female plants develops attractive white feathery plumes that persist into summer. Consider planting next to mature Blackwood or Lightwood for a natural trellis. Can be successfully trained up wire fences or trellis for screening. Reasonably long lived if treated well, drought resistant, but responds well to extra watering.
