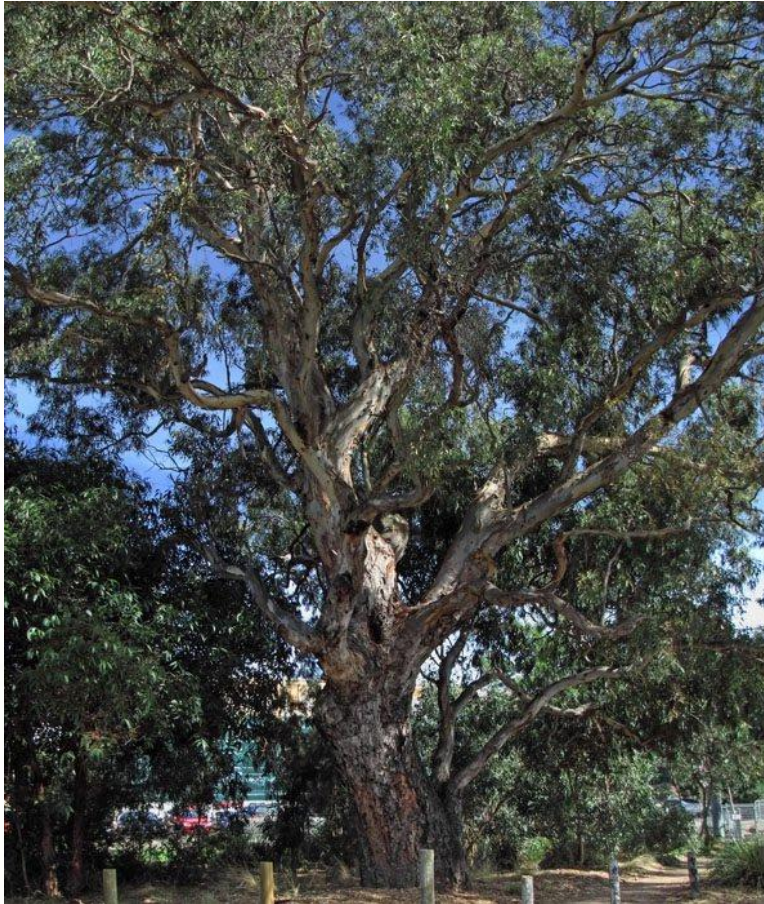


River Red Gum *Eucalyptus camaldulensis*

Flowers: November to March - H 12-30m x W 15-20m.



An iconic tree that is widely distributed across Australia. The River Red Gum grows mainly along waterways & in & around wetlands areas, preferring deep sandy/alluvial soils. Mature trees host an enormous number and variety of animal and insect species. Long-lived & will need plenty of room grow & spread. River Red Gums take a hundred or more years to reach their full size. The River Red Gum in the image opposite is well over a hundred years old.
