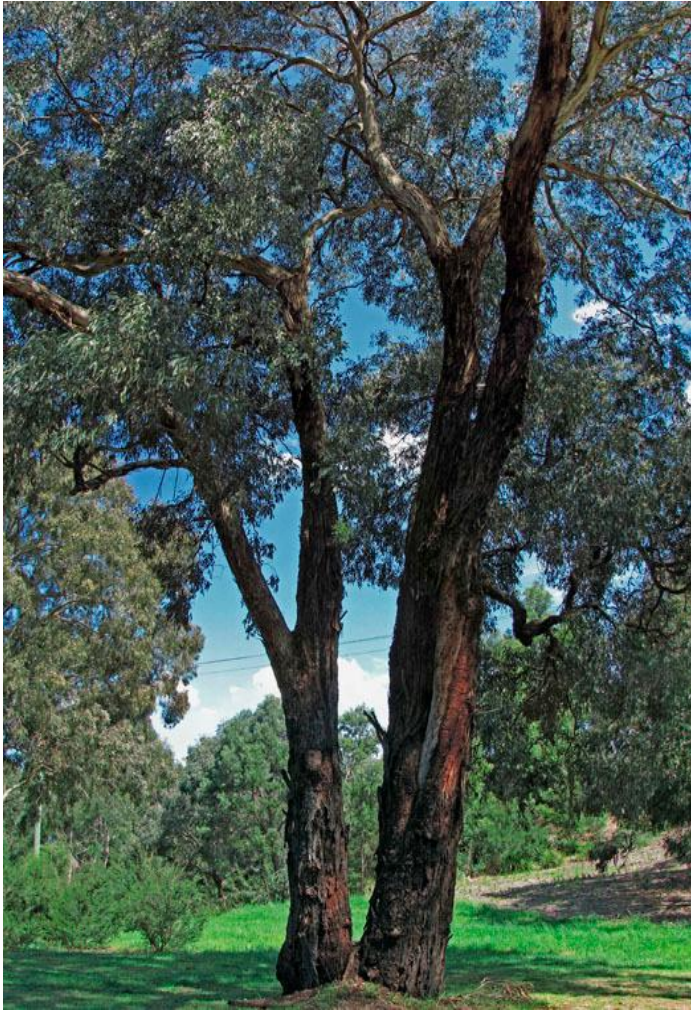


Yellow Box *Eucalyptus melliodora*

Flowers: October to March - H 10-25m x W 8-20m.



Medium to tall tree with a spreading canopy, preferring well drained light clay & sandy soils. Lower bark becomes dark and rough with age & is very variable within the species with its upper branches pale and creamy. Drought tolerant & long-lived. Considered to be one of the best honey trees. The showy flowers are white to cream, attracting honey-eaters & parrots throughout its flowering period. Remnant Yellow Box are rare, with only a few remaining across the Sandbelt region.
