

Narrow-Leaved Peppermint *Eucalyptus radiata*

Flowers: October - January. H 10-15+m x W up to 10m.



Compact tree with a fibrous bark persistent to its higher branches. Creamy white flowers in spring to early January. Adaptable to wide variety of soils, but prefers well drained sandy soils & tolerates only moderate water-logging. *E. radiata* is becoming popular in urban areas & is increasingly being used as a street tree because of its compact crown, dense canopy & excellent form. Leaves have a peppermint smell when crushed.
