

Scrambling Coral Fern *Gleichenia microphylla*

Spreading to H 3+ m



Scrambling Coral Fern has a scrambling habit reaching its full height by being supported by other vegetation or by forming a thicket. Growing in shaded permanently waterlogged soils, in cool, sheltered gullies, swamps within heathlands eucalypt forest & woodland. Scrambling Coral Fern is hardy & can tolerate salt laden winds in coastal environs. Will not tolerate its root zone completely drying out. Rare in cultivation, & is almost extinct across the Sandbelt.
