

Running Postman *Kennedia prostrata*

Flowers: April to December. Prostrate spreading 1 – 2 to 5m.



Attractive trailing ground cover with bright red flowers on stringy runners up to over 1 metre long. Prefers sunny positions or dappled shade in moist well drained soils, but will do well in dry areas if watered & not left to dry-out. Noted as an excellent plant for growing in rockeries on embankments & in hanging baskets. Light pruning can be beneficial. Can be short lived, but Running Postman is a delight to have around
