

Woolly Tea-tree *Leptospermum lanigerum*

Flowers: September to January - H 2-6m - W 1-3m.



Woolly Tea-tree makes a attractive garden plant usually reaching 2 or more metres. Grows in moist to wetter soils; preferring full sun or partial shade, withstanding dry periods. Flowers are followed by woody seed capsules; which remain unopened until they drop from the plant or the plant dies. Regular pruning makes a denser shrub.
