

Australian or Sprawling Bluebell *Wahlenbergia gracilis*

Flowers: September to October. H 10 - 50cm x W 10 - 30cm.



Quick growing with masses of tiny blue flower on twining wiry stems. Prefers moist to drier soils; responds very well if watered occasionally. Prefers part shade, but can cope with full sun. Will readily self-sow if areas of bare soil are near. Plant among the Wallaby-grasses the Bluebells wiry stems will twine among the grasses and fill them with splashes of lovely blue flowers. Takes well to being cut back occasionally.
