

Small Grass-tree *Xanthorrhoea minor*

Flowers: November to December. H 60cm+ x W 1m.



Although not commonly cultivated, *X.minor* can make an excellent garden plant. Very hardy, slow growing & long lived. Requiring well drained soils in full sun to dappled shade. Flowers are produced on tall spear-like shaft/s with masses of small creamy-yellow nectar rich flowers. Some sources estimate that flowering can be achieved in four years after planting, but it may take longer. *X. minor* can make an excellent container plant. Nectar rich flowers bloom profusely after fires & attracting insects & birds.
