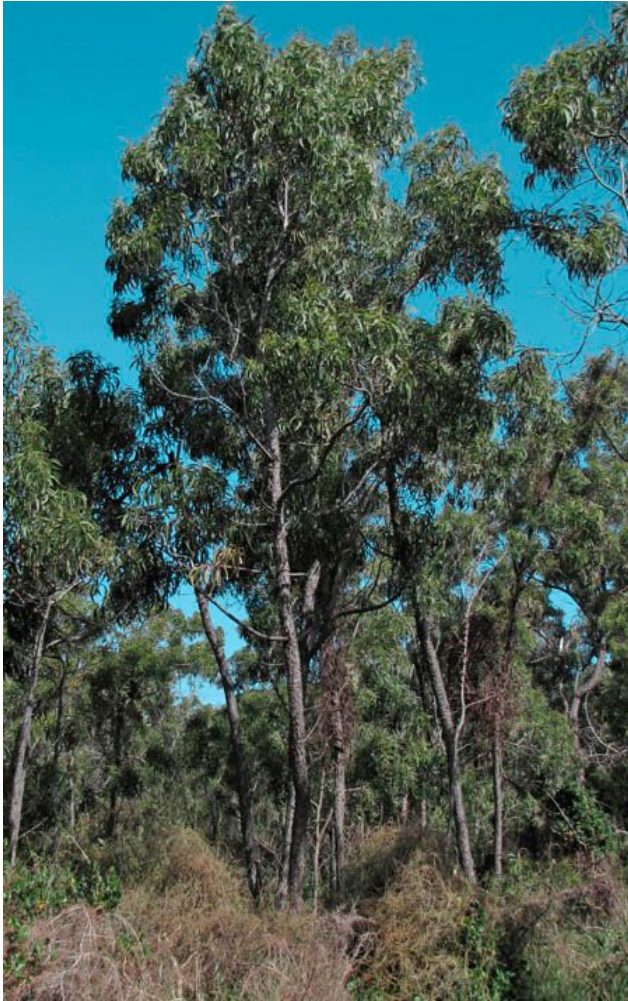


Lightwood *Acacia implexa*

Flowers: October to January. H 5-8m x W 2-4m



Graceful small to medium tree with attractive curved light-green leaves & rough bark. Flowers in dense clusters of cream-yellow balls during summer & sometimes again in autumn. Prefers well drained sandy soils. Will establish itself if planted in very shaded positions. Long-lived & drought tolerant, with the potential to be planted more widely as a suburban tree. For maximum effect plant Lightwood in groups.
