

Sallow Wattle *Acacia longifolia* subsp. *longifolia*

Flowers: June to November. H 1.5-10m x W 6-10m.

Commonly an erect shrub to medium tree with light-green leaves & lemon-yellow flower spikes. Prefers well drained sandy soils. Reasonably long-lived & drought tolerant. Has the potential to be planted more widely as a suburban tree. Sallow Wattle is similar to its close cousin Coast Wattle & are often confused with each other. Given the time to grow to maturity Sallow Wattle can make a superb garden tree.
